He studied Acting at HB studio and the Michael Howard Studio in NYC and has performed on radio, stage, screen and television in New York and throughout the United States. He is the host of the Top 1% Ranked Podcast 7 Minute Stories, which was featured nationally on the NPR hit show Snap Judgement in 2019, in May of 2021, Aaron was invited to be a collaborative podcast producer at Lemonpie.
